Below is an update to the Captains Golf Course operations that will take effect on Friday, May 22:

1. It is still a requirement that all players have a tee time reservation in order to play. Walk-ons will not be accepted. This includes the early morning back 9 play. Please use the on-line system to make your reservations. Day of play reservations must be made by calling the shop. Reservations for back 9 play may be made on-line as well, although those in the "Morning" membership category will need to call the shop for back 9 reservations on Fridays, Saturdays or Sundays.

2. Members may bring guests for play. Please make reservations via the on-line system. After the member makes the tee time, the green fees must be prepaid with a credit card by calling the pro shop.

3. General public may reserve tee times one day prior to the play date. General public reservations can only be made by calling the pro shop and green fees will be charged at the time the reservation is made.

4. Golf carts will continue to be limited to members and their guests who have supplied the required documentation for handicap use. All carts will continue to be single rider.

5. We will be using 15 minute tee time intervals.

6. At this point there will be no food and beverage offerings. The Freemans Grill is planning to begin offering a grab and go service beginning Friday, May 29.

7. The clubhouse restrooms will be open for use. Those using the restroom must wear a face covering. There will be signage posted indicating the limits for how many people will be allowed in the restroom at a time. In addition, the restrooms at the snack bar adjacent to the Port 10 tee will be open to the golfers. There are no porta-johns currently on the golf course.

8. There is no drinking water provided on the golf course.

9. There are no trash recepticles on the course. What you carry in, you carry out.

10. Scorecards will not be available at the course at this time. We have posted a pdf of a scorecard on our web site. You can download the scorecard by <u>CLICKING HERE</u>.

11. Pro shop merchandise will be available for sale by calling ahead, paying by credit card, and we will place the items in a bag outside the pro shop for pick up.

12. We remain limited in regard to the number of staff we are allowed on site, so please use the online reservation system whenever possible. 13. Players will still be required to remain in their vehicles until 15 minutes prior to their tee time and they must return to their vehicle immediately following their round. No gathering.

14. The driving range and the practice putting greens will remain closed.

15. All players are required to practice social distancing, stay six feet apart. Masks are required when a person enters a building or cannot practice social distancing for any reason.
